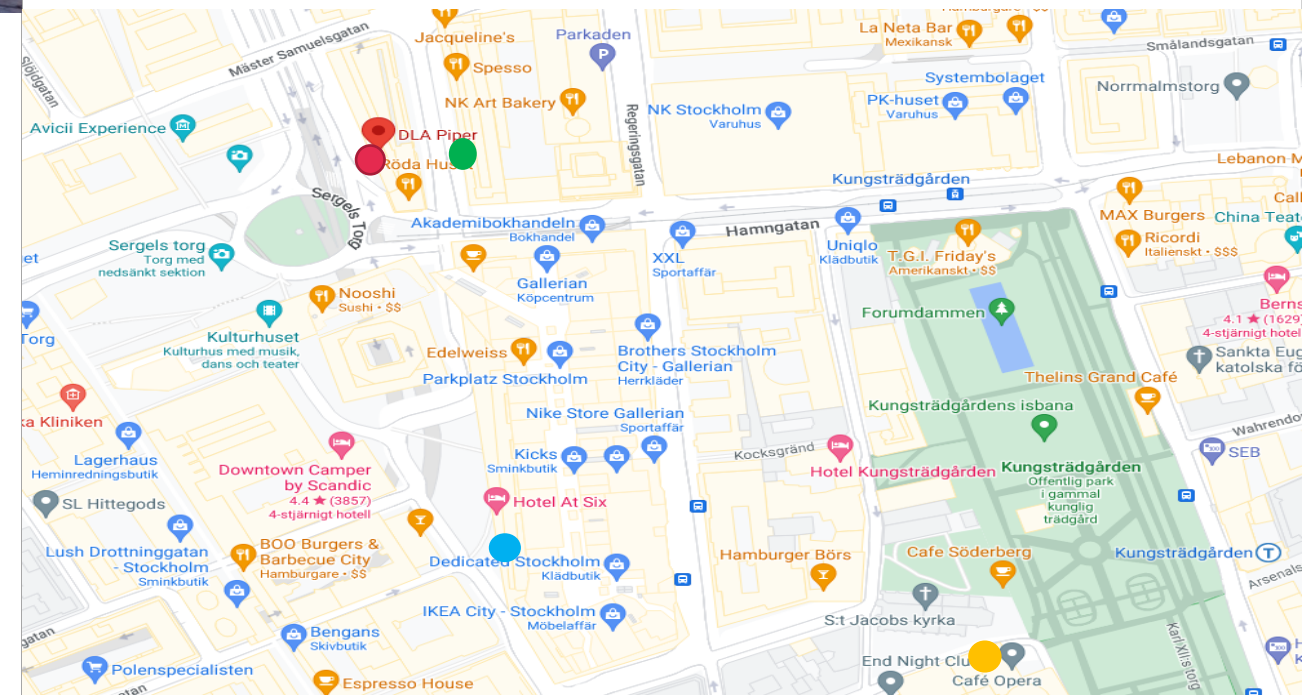
Map of Locations

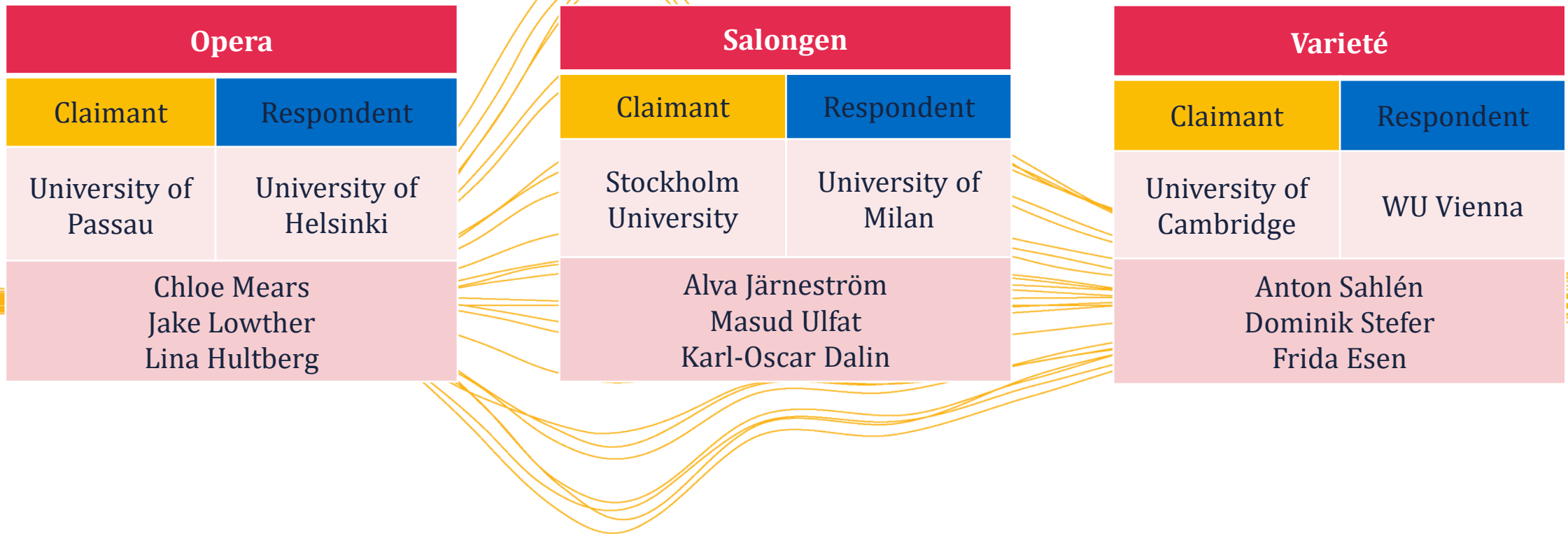

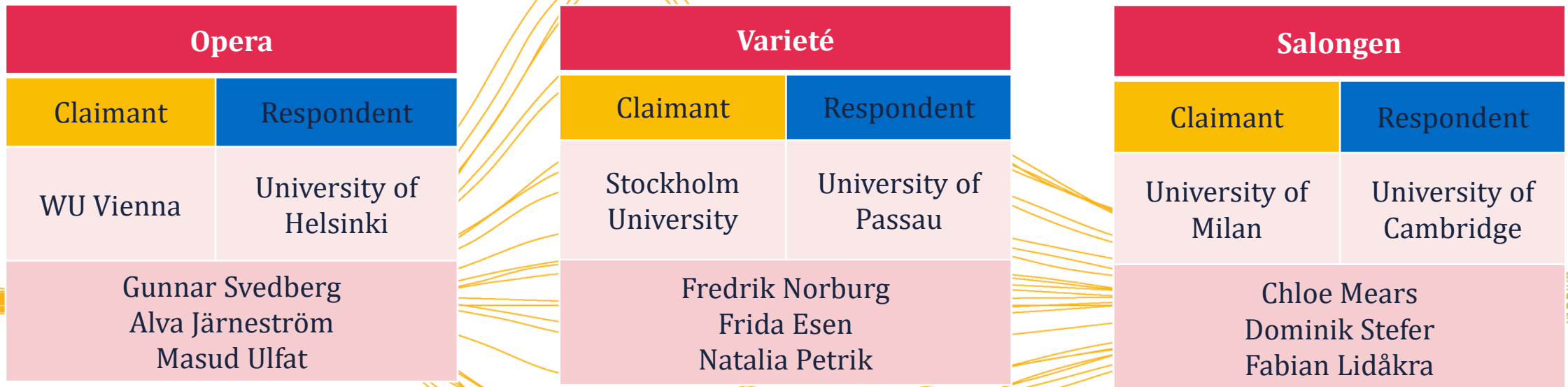

Scoring

The participating teams will be evaluated by using a standardised scoring sheet. The scoring system and the evaluation grounds used in the DLA Piper Pre-Moot reflect the scoring system and grounds used at the oral rounds in Vienna. However, the arbitrators may provide the participants with some further oral feedback in addition to scoring them after each round. The total score for each team will be calculated after the second round of arguments.

Based on these scores, the two teams with the highest average points will compete against each other in the final, which is organized as the last Pre-Moot hearing on Saturday evening. The completed scoring sheets (with the arbitrators' names removed) can be distributed upon request to the participating teams after the Pre-Moot.
